

Stimulus Roads Program Begins

Parking Regulations Announced

The City of Amsterdam/NYS DOT/Callanan Industries announces that as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act that milling and paving is scheduled to begin on Monday, May 3, 2010. Parking will be prohibited on the following posted streets, during milling and paving operations, beginning Monday at 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m., **weather permitting**.

Residents of streets to be milled will be given sufficient prior notice to remove parked vehicles from posted streets. All illegally parked vehicles on posted streets to be milled will be towed at owner's expense.
