Ordinance Number 2013-B (to be known as Ordinance 2013-1 if adopted)

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 228 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF AMSTERDAM**

**BY: MAYOR THANE**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to revise the city code to modify the winter parking rules to facilitate snow removal,

The City of Amsterdam, in Common Council convened, does hereby,

**ORDAIN AND ENACT** as follows:

Chapters § 228-28 “Winter Parking; Street Maintenance,” § 228-30 “Authority to impound vehicles,” and § 228-53 “Schedule XIX Time Limit Parking” of the code of the City of Amsterdam are hereby amended as indicated below: (underlined text is added and struck through text is to be deleted)

§ 228-28. Winter Parking; Street Maintenance

A. Except as otherwise posted, winter parking rules shall be in effect throughout the City between November 1 and the following April 1 as follows:

1. Alternate parking with odd-side parking on odd-numbered days and even side parking on even-numbered days. The effective time for such alternate parking shall commence 6:00 p.m. of the day prior to the day of permissible parking to 6:00 p.m. of the following day.

2. Posting of this general rule shall be deemed sufficient if placed at each vehicular entry to the City.

3. On those streets where parking is normally permitted on one side of the street only by other parking ordinances heretofore adopted, the alternate parking scheme defined above shall not apply, instead in the event of a snow fall of greater than 3 inches parking on those streets is prohibited for 24 hours after the snow fall. Streets where this rule is in effect shall be so posted. parking is permitted the Mayor and/or the Director of Public Works, during the winter period set forth, may, by due notice given, suspend parking on either side of such streets for the limited period of time declared, not to exceed 24 hours, and for the purpose of proper street maintenance, including snow removal.

4. Notification of these rules shall be given to the media each year at least two weeks in advance of the November 1 implementation date.

5. SNOW EMERGENCY – When a snowfall of greater than 4 inches is forecast the Mayor may proclaim a snow emergency. This proclamation shall be published to all local news providers. The proclamation shall suspend parking on all city streets for a specified period up to 36 hours after the end of the snowfall.

B. The Mayor, Department of Public Works General Foreman, or the Chief of Police is authorized to suspend parking on any street in the City of Amsterdam for a period not to exceed 72 24 hours, provided that any suspension of parking must be preceeded by notice to the public in the form of ~~temporary no parking signs posted 24 prior to the parking suspension~~ a public notice published in the official newspaper of the city. ~~On any street in the City where parking has been suspended, temporary no parking signs must be posted.~~

228-30 Authority to impound vehicles

- A. When any vehicle is parked or abandoned on any highway or public parking lot within this City during a snowstorm, flood, fire or other public emergency which affects that portion of the public highway or parking lot upon which said vehicle is parked or abandoned, said vehicle may be removed by or under the direction of the City Police Department.
- B. When any vehicle is found unattended on any highway or public parking lot within the City where said vehicle constitutes an obstruction to traffic, said vehicle may be removed by or under the direction of the City Police Department.
- C. When any vehicle is found parked in violation of any winter parking rule set forth in section 228-28 or in violation of a parking ban established by a snow emergency, then said vehicle may be removed by or under the direction of the City Police Department.
- D. When any vehicle is found unattended on any highway or public parking lot within the City where said vehicle constitutes an obstruction to planned road maintenance, said vehicle may be removed by or under the direction of the City Police Department.
- E. When any vehicle is found unattended on any public parking lot within the City where said vehicle is in violation of any provision of Chapter 228, said vehicle may be removed by or under the direction of the City Police Department.
