RESOLUTION ADOPTING 2013-2014 OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF AMSTERDAM

BY: MAYOR THANE AND BUDGET REVIEW BOARD

WHEREAS, the proposed budget for the fiscal year 2013-2014 for the City of Amsterdam, NY, was adopted by the Budget Review Board on May 11, 2013, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed budget was held on May 21, 2013, and

WHEREAS, the Budget Review Board has deliberated upon the comments of the public, and considered all information before the Board,

RESOLVED, that the proposed budget as amended is hereby adopted as the final budget for fiscal year 2013-2014, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the tax rate on real property and various user fees are hereby set for 2013 to 2014 fiscal year as follows: property tax rate is set at \$15.57 per thousand of assessed value, one unit of flat rate water is set at \$367.84, one unit of flat rate sewer is set at \$268.40 and one unit of flat rate sanitation is set at \$235.88, and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the rates set forth on the attached meter rate schedule are hereby set for the 2013 to 2014 fiscal year.
